

7 of the best things to do in

KAKADU

dry season

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Explore the Park – Free ranger activities – see the ‘What’s On Guide (available free throughout the Park). Bowali Visitor Centre and Warradjan Cultural Centre are both ‘must see’. Sunsets from Ubirr, Nawurlandja or Yellow Waters area, unforgettable! Rock art at Ubirr and Nourlangie Rock easily accessible. Highly recommended: Mamukala bird and wetlands viewing, Bardedjilidji walk, Mangarre walk, the various waterfalls (including Gunlom and Maguk). There is a lot more to do and some special activities may require a separate permit from Parks.



Cruise – Kakadu boasts two fabulous boat cruises. The famous Yellow Water cruise from Cooida explores a vast wetland wilderness. Guluyambi cruises explore the spectacular East Alligator River. They are different and you may see crocodiles on both!
Tours operate from Cooida and East Alligator



Animal Tracks Safari – Authentic Aboriginal Bush Food and Wildlife specialists. It’s in a class of its own. Experience hands-on Aboriginal bush life, search for wildlife, and savour a sunset campfire cook-up of bush tucker gathered throughout the afternoon. The safari has exclusive access to view a mid-Dry season phenomenal bird gathering. This non-commercialised and eye-opening tour is unique only to Kakadu!

Fly – The spectacular rock formations of the Arnhem Land Escarpment and the wetlands of Kakadu are awesome from the air. Planes are great and depart from Cooida and Jabiru airport. Helicopter adventures depart Jabiru airport. It really is the ‘birds eye’ view of Kakadu.
Tours operate from Jabiru, Jabiru Airport and Cooida



Catch a Barra – Australia’s greatest freshwater sports fish is teeming in the waters of Kakadu. Experienced fishing guides based at Cooida and Jabiru can help you lure a wild barra. It’s not just a day fishing, but an opportunity to explore the waterways and wildlife of Kakadu in your own small group.
Tours operate from Jabiru and Cooida



Waterfalls, Waterholes and Escarpments – Jim Jim Falls, Twin Falls, Gunlom (with a natural infinity pool up top) and Maguk are iconic, but there is so much more to the Escarpment Country. Waterfall flow and waterhole levels vary seasonally, but the natural settings of all are absolutely unique and world-class.
Tours operate from Jabiru and Cooida



Other great experiences – Ayal Tours are led by a well-known Kakadu man and visit several great locations including Ubirr rock art site. Overnight wilderness camps, Hawk Dreaming Wilderness Lodge and Kakadu Billabong Safari Camp offer exclusive experiences. Venture into Arnhem Land with one of several organised quality day tours.
